

CARBON MONOXIDE KILLS IN LESS THAN THREE MINUTES !!!



BEWARE: The symptoms for carbon monoxide poisoning are similar to the flu, a virus or food poisoning.

Is there a “silent killer” on your boat?

- Fit a CO alarm that is suitable for marine use and meets British Safety Standards (BS EN 50291-2).
- Ensure you keep the cabin well ventilated
- Check the flues of coal or wood burning stoves for signs of leaks or blockages.
- Dispose of embers carefully. They could cause a build-up of CO.
- Standard BBQs should never be used on boats.

Carbon Monoxide (CO) is a colourless, odourless, highly poisonous gas that can kill in minutes. Carbon Monoxide poisoning can be caused by ANY fuel that burns or smoulders.

Watch out for the symptoms –

- Mild headache
- Dizziness
- Nausea
- Vomiting
- Fatigue
- Drowsiness
